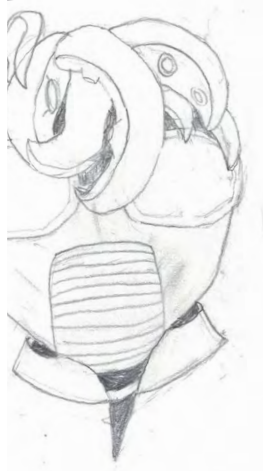
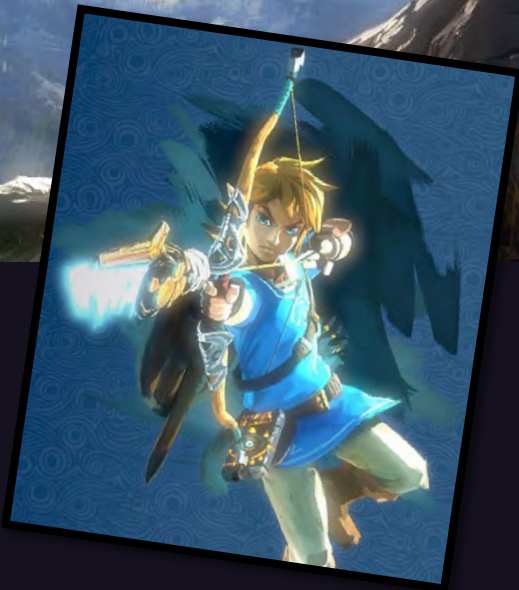

SUPER MARIO MAKER 2

Is Super Mario Maker 2 worth it?

Why should you get yet another Mario game?

STORY MODE: Like all other Mario games, the story line in Super Mario Maker 2 is very basic. Peach's castle has been destroyed and it is your job to rebuild it. The story levels are very creative.

COURSE MAKER: The course maker is where you can make levels. If you have no idea where to start you can go through the tutorial which shows you the basics. It is easier to make levels with the Switch's touch screen, but you can also do it with a controller. The course maker is what makes this game unique.

COURSE BOT: When you save a level you created, you can go into course bot and choose to upload your level. Before you can upload your level you must successfully complete your own course.

COURSE WORLD: Course world is where you can play other people's levels. You can find newly uploaded levels, popular levels, and use a detailed search to find certain types of levels. You can also check the stats of your uploaded levels. So as long as people play the game, there will be more than enough levels to choose from.

NETWORK PLAY: In network play you can play with your friends locally. Multiplayer co-op is where you can group up with random people and play the level with them. Multiplayer verses is where you also group up with random people, but you race to the flagpole. The multiplayer with other people is sometimes laggy. And finally endless challenge is where you choose a level difficulty and it picks random levels other people have made and you see how many levels you can complete.

CONCLUSION: Super Mario Maker 2 has its ups and its downs but overall it's a great game. The lag only seems to show up in the multiplayer. Because you can make levels and play levels others have made, Super Mario Maker 2 is a game with endless possibilities.

They came upon brick floating in the air

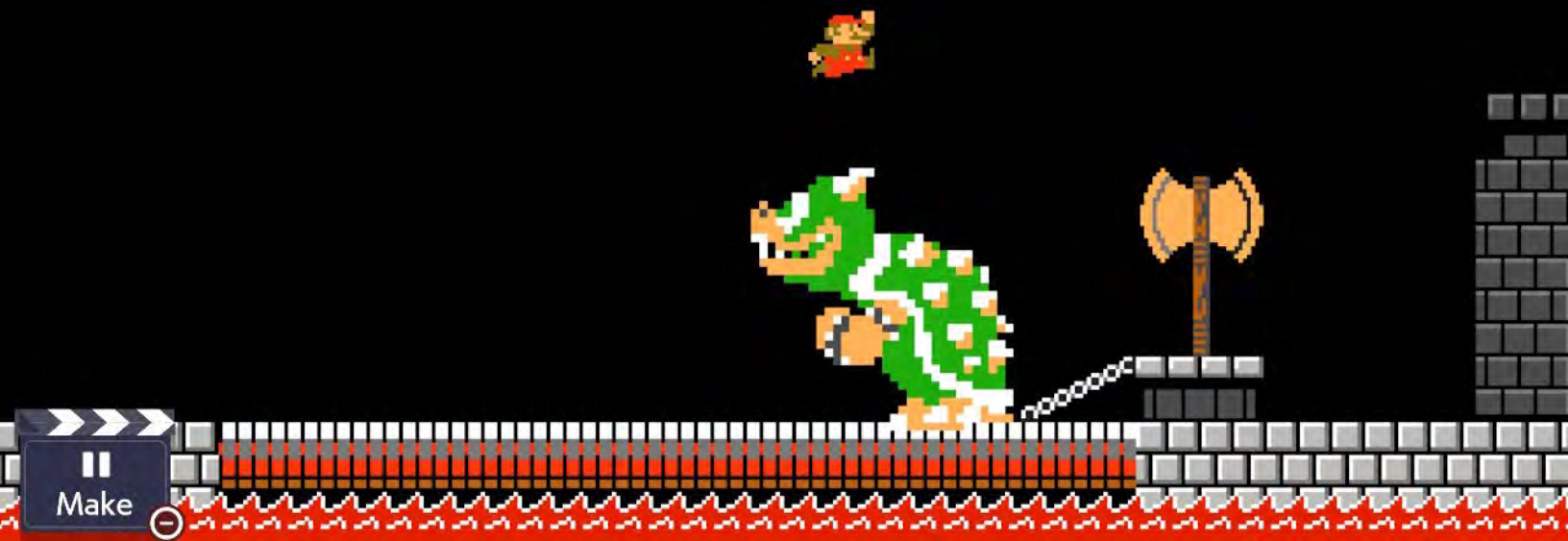
And hit their heads on the blocks bearing gifts.

Mario was done for, Bowser would see to that.

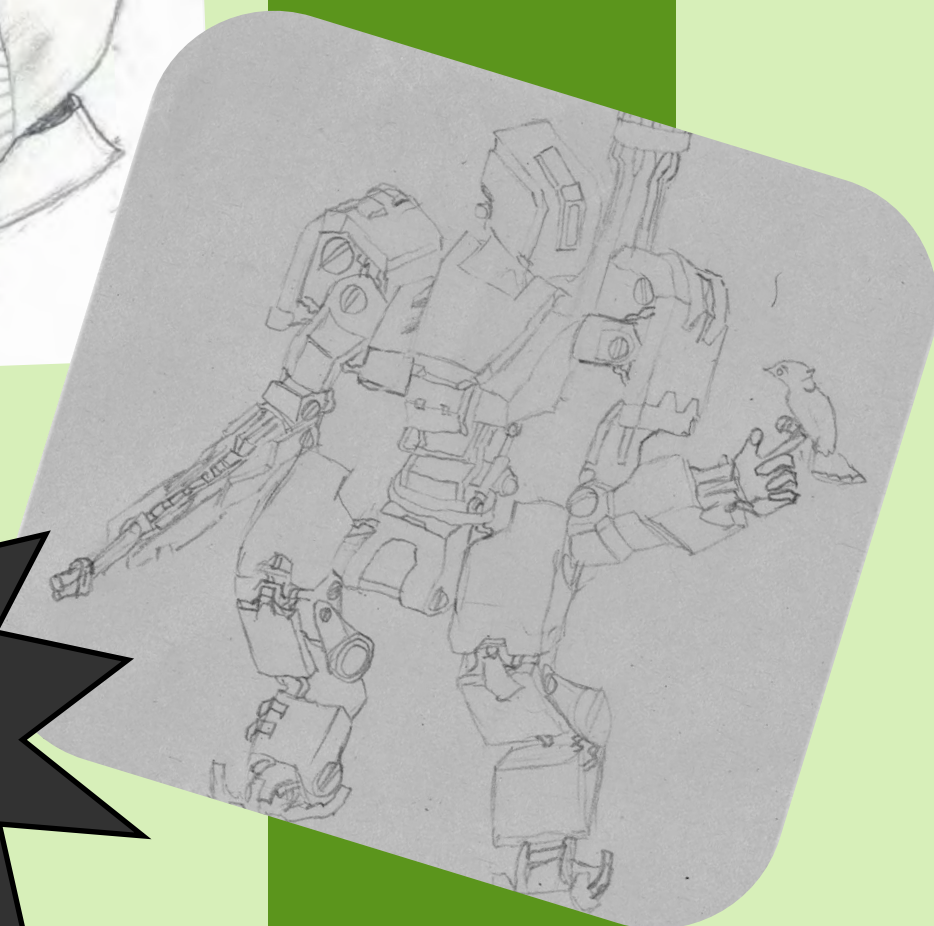
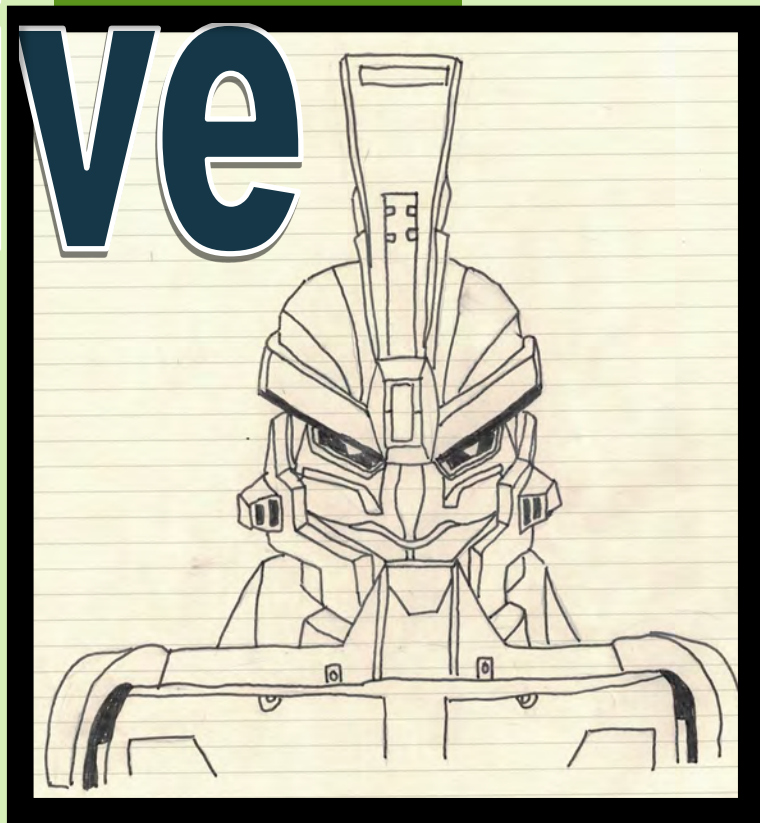
Mario saw the big beast and bounced up high

Over his head, summersaulting, landing just out of reach.

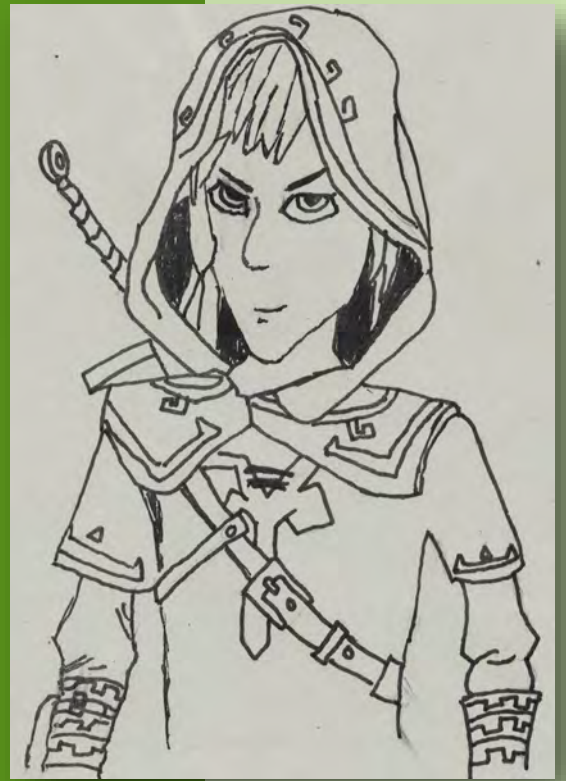
He activated Bowser's own trap and the bridge collapsed.

HOW TO REPLACE YOUR LEFT JOY CON STICK ON YOUR NINTENDO SWITCH

Does your Nintendo Switch joy con have drift? I'm going to tell you how to replace your joy con stick.

We will need a few different types of screw drivers and a



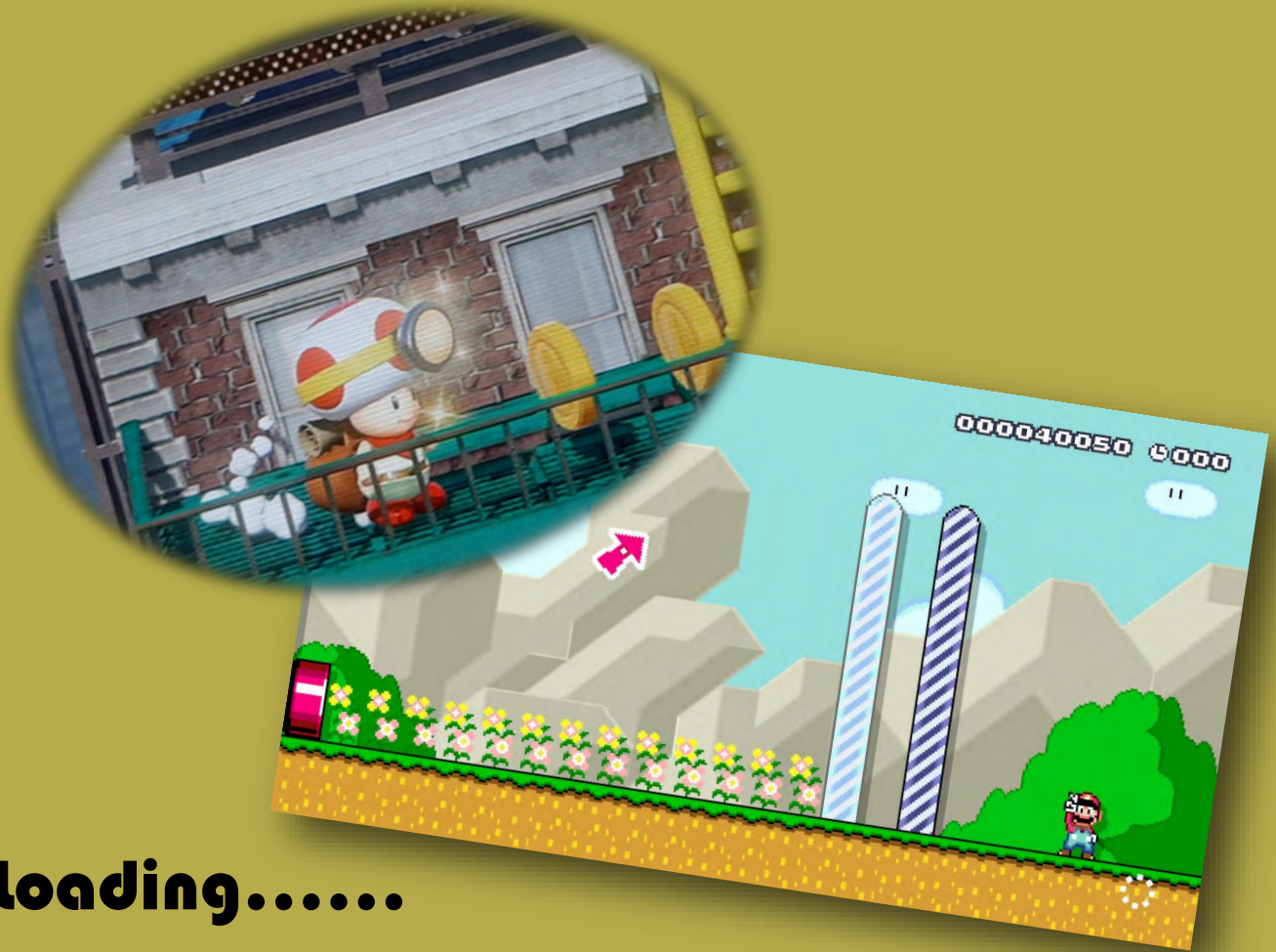
replacement joy con stick.

The first thing you need to do is unscrew the screws on the back of the joy con.

Then you pry off the back of the joy con and you pull out the battery. Be careful here because it has wires connected to it. You unscrew the battery holder by taking out the top right screw and bottom left screw and the ones at the very top and bottom.

Then you find the joy con stick and follow the ribbon cable to its spot and then you carefully lift the latch. You, then pull it out unscrew the joy con and put in your new stick. Screw the new stick in and attach the new the ribbon cable. Note it's very hard to put the ribbon cable in its spot. The last step is to put everything back together and test if it works.

Then you're done! Now you can play all your games again.
